STATUTORY DECLARATION ON RTI ACT

This document serves as the official statutory declaration by the National College of Pharmacy, affirming its commitment to uphold the provisions of the Right to Information (RTI) Act. The college acknowledges its responsibility to enable citizens to access information within the purview of public authorities. This commitment is aimed at fostering transparency and accountability across all levels of public administration, while also recognizing the establishment of both Central Information Commission and State Information Commissions, as well as any related or incidental matters outlined under Section 4(1)(b) of the RTI Act of 2005, as originally issued and subsequently amended.

The RTI Act

The Right to Information Act, 2005 (22 of 2005) has been enacted by the Parliament and has come into force from 15 June, 2005. This Act provides for right to information for citizens to secure access to information under the control of public authorities in order to promote transparency and accountability in the working of every public authority. All Universities and Colleges established by law made by Parliament or by State Legislature or by notification by the appropriate Government or owned, controlled or substantially financed directly or indirectly by funds provided by the Government shall come within the meaning of a Public Authority under this Act.

Whereas, some provisions of this Act have come into effect immediately on its enactment (ie on 15 June 2005), other provisions shall come into effect on 100/120 days of its enactment. All Universities and Colleges are therefore advised to carefully go through this Act and take necessary steps for implementation of various provisions including proactive disclosure of certain kind of information. Such information shall be made available to the public at large through the website by the concerned University/College.
